The Eucharistic Revival- The Eucharist, did you know?

How does the real presence make a difference in our lives? We believe that God's real presence continues today in our lives and in the Church, especially in the sacraments. Fr. Kenan Osborne, outlines how our appreciation of Christ's real presence also becomes the foundation of our spirituality. "Eucharist speaks to us about the presence of Jesus. Indeed, the real presence of Jesus is the key to Eucharistic theology. It is also the key to Eucharistic spirituality. Again, we do not 'see' Jesus as present; we must believe that Jesus is present in the Eucharistic meal. Every Eucharist, then, if celebrated correctly, deepens our faith in the Lord's presence (Sacramental Theology, p.133). Pope Benedict XVI reminds us that "God encounters us ever anew, in the men and women who reflect God's presence, in God's word, in the sacraments, and especially in the Eucharist. In the Church's liturgy, in her prayer, in the living community of believers, we experience the love of God, we perceive God's presence and we thus learn to recognize that presence in our daily lives" (On Christian Love).

So as we take Christ into our mouths and into our heart, let us become more and more like Christ himself. In this way we will more faithfully imitate his love and our lives will radiate with his compassion for others and his concern for justice. As Teresa of Avila recognized, "Christ has no body now on earth but yours, no hands but yours, no feet but yours; yours are the eyes through which to look at Christ's compassion to the world, yours are the feet with which he is to go about doing good, and yours are the hands with which he is to bless us now." *Used with permission from God's Real Presence, by Steve Mueller. 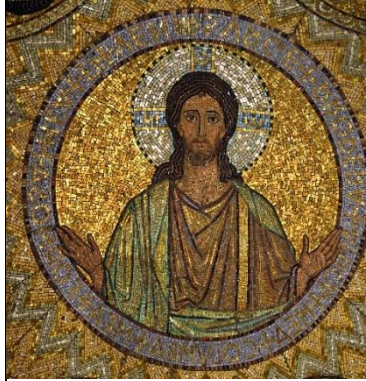
