Lt. Col. Richard Mock

Enlisted in the Army at the outbreak of WW II. He was a pilot and flew 57 combat missions and earned the "Distinguished Flying Cross" and "Purple Heart" medals. He was a devout Catholic. He later became Commander of the First Tactical Fighter Group headquartered in Vermont. He was the uncle of Paul Canavan.
