



THE EUCHARISTIC REVIVAL- THE EUCHARIST, DID YOU KNOW? The Eucharistic Revival- The Eucharist, did you know?

Why do we call this Eucharistic presence "real"? The word real comes from a Latin word, res, realis which means thing. So, to identify this presence as real, "thing-like", is meant to convey the sense that it is the presence of one "thing" to another, not just a fleeting change by an enduring reality, like the thing rather than its changing features.

Pope Paul VI explained the Church's use of term this way. "This presence is called 'real'- by which is not intended to exclude the other types of presence as if they could not be 'real' too, but because it is presence in the fullest sense: that is to say it is a substantial presence by which Christ, divine and human, makes himself wholly and entirely present" (Mystery of Faith, 1995). 


