

THE EUCHARISTIC REVIVAL- THE EUCHARIST, DID YOU KNOW?

How long does the change in substance last? Since the change in substance is a change in the thing itself, it lasts until it is no more. For us, the substantial change in the bread and wine remains until these are changed into our substance as happens to all food through digestion. This also helps to explain the reverence for the bread that extends beyond the actual Mass.

In the early Church as today, the Eucharistic bread is taken to those in the community who could not be part of the Sunday Eucharist, especially those who are ill or in danger of death. The Eucharistic bread is also reserved in a special location in our churches (the tabernacle) and brought forth for reverent adoration. The ceremony called "Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament" allows us to reverence Christ present with us and to be blessed with the Eucharistic bread. 




