



IN THE PEWS

EMPOWERING A CHRISTIAN RESPONSE TO TRAUMA & ADDICTION IN OUR WORLD

TRAUMA RECOVERY

Trauma can wound individuals and rupture relationships. Pastoral care is where most people turn for help, before even consulting a therapist. From disclosures during parish work through the annulment process, Catholics become confidantes to people who are facing grave wounds inflicted by increasing degrees of interpersonal aggression and violence in society. Teresa Pitt Green provides practical guidance and clear do's and don'ts for trauma-informed pastoral care.

ADDICTION RECOVERY

Lives, families, and ministries can be staggered and even broken by the effects of addiction to substances such as alcohol and drugs, as well as to processes such as gambling, gaming, and porn. Often the loved ones of addicts turn to the Church for guidance and help. Fr. Tom Hoar and Deacon Steven DeMartino provide an up-close look at the reality of addiction in 2023 and practical guidance on how to minister to lives crippled by addiction and the despair it creates.

THE OCCULT & DELIVERANCE

Interest in the occult and other practices associated with the demonic are on the rise. Many people venture into these practices as a method of coping and healing, inadvertently opening their lives to demonic influences and spirits. Occult practices have moved from the more obvious Tarot cards and conjuring of spirits into an online world where the triggers for invitation are far more subtle, but no less effective. Learn how to identify these spiritual hazards and how to understand the reality of deliverance enough to help the afflicted find a path to liberation.






