Inevitably, during a car ride, talking over coffee, or in response to an injustice they’ve observed, people will ask, “Why?” and “How?” and “Why me?” And when they do, make sure you’re ready to engage them truthfully and compassionately, pushing them—graciously and by the Spirit—to Jesus and his gospel, which can make sense of all they’re experiencing. Be the person in their life who has the answer-FAITH!
