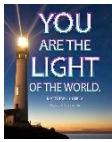

Knights of Columbus News: The Catholic Man of the Month in the January/February 2026 Columbia Magazine is Blessed Michal Sopocko, who was a priest-theologian (1888-1975). Born to Polish parents, Father Sopocko was ordained in 1914 and served as a military chaplain in 1919. He met Sister Faustina in 1933 and became the Message of Divine Mercy's greatest proponent, commissioning the first Divine Mercy Image and publishing pamphlets about the chaplet. During 1938, due to the Gestapo raids, Fr. Sopocko developed a new religious congregation devoted to Divine Mercy. In 1942, under Nazi occupation, the Congregation of the Sisters of the Divine Mercy was established. Fr. Sopocko was beatified by Pope Benedict XVI in 2008.

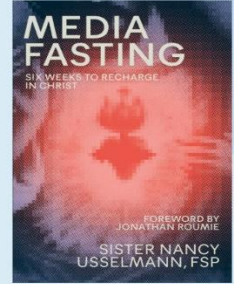

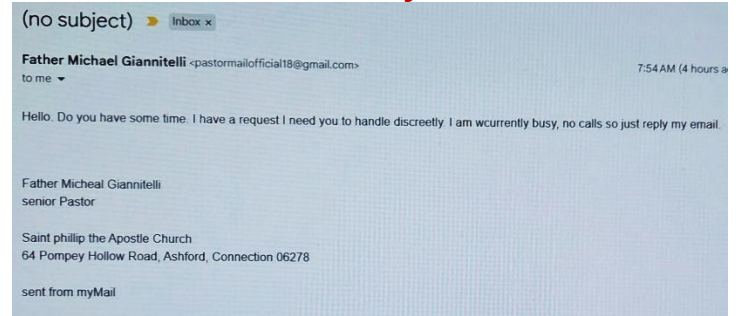
CATHOLIC SCHOOLS BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT
